Supporting the natural growth of the vine (liana plant) by minimal pruning

- **Comments on sustainability:**

Less working hours are necessary due to the minimal pruning and the plants are more resistant to diseases, so less field crossings are necessary. This reduces the fuel and pesticide need, with a positive effect on soil organisms and soil structure (e.g. higher infiltration rate and water storing capacity). External agricultural advice is advisable.
